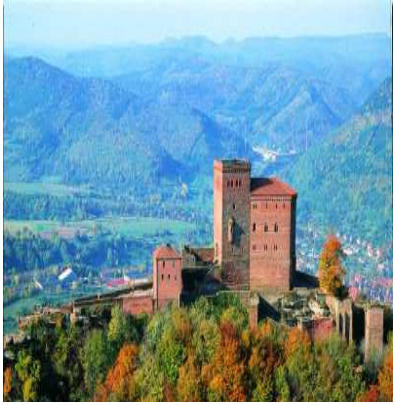

Saturday, 14 Oct.: MAULBRONN/PALATINATE /WINEFESTIVAL



MAULBRONN: (UNESCO World Heritage), a fully preserved former monastery from the 12th/13th century where Hermann Hesse went to school.
Visit of the scenic wine-growing area of the **Palatinate: Burg Trifels**, an ancient imperial fortress on a lofty crag with a superb view of the Palatinate Forest and the Rhine valley, formerly the imperial treasury and state prison.
Trip along the **Deutsche Weinstraße**.
Visit of the **“Festival of New Wine”** in **Landau**: marked by a pleasantly rustic atmosphere, this traditional festival honors New Wine with a colourful music program, wine huts and palatine specialities.

Sunday, 22 October: FREIBURG / BLACK FOREST I

FREIBURG: Walk through the “Capital of the Black Forest”, including a visit to the cathedral with „Christendom’s finest spire” and the western portal with remarkable sculptures; cathedral square with Historic Merchants’ Hall; Old and New City Hall, Old University, House of the Whale and the typical Freiburg “Bächle”.
Trip to the **Schauinsland mountain** with great panorama view across the Black Forest and the Rhine valley.

Wednesday, 01 November (holiday): FREIBURG / BLACK FOREST II

Friday, 03 Nov. – Sunday, 05 Nov.: HAMBURG

This trip takes us to two famous Northern German ports and trading cities (cities of the Hanseatic League).



HAMBURG: bus tour of the city, walk through the city centre with City Hall and Exchange, Jungfernstieg, church of St. Michael’s including ascent of the “Michel” tower (emblem of the city), Nikolaifleet (ensemble of old Hamburg houses), Speicherstadt (UNESCO World Heritage), St. Pauli-landing bridges with visit of the traditional **Fish Market**, **harbour tour**.

BREMEN: walk through Germany’s oldest port, market square with historical City Hall, the “Bremen Town Musicians” and statue of Roland (UNESCO World Heritage), Schnoorviertel: a well-preserved quarter of old crooked lanes.

Price: 75,- Euros (incl. transport, tours, fees, harbour tour, 2 overnight stays with breakfast in city hostel in Hamburg)

Saturday, 11 November: WEIMAR



The “city of German classicism” (UNESCO World Heritage): Goethe House, Schiller House, Wittumspalais, German National Theatre, Castle, Gothic Herder Church with famous altar by Lucas Cranach, impressive market square, park on the river Ilm with Goethe’s garden house, Bauhaus-University.

Saturday, 25 November: COLOGNE

Explore a city that is over 2000 years old: Cathedral/Dom (UNESCO World Heritage, epitome of Gothic architecture and Germany’s most famous architectural monument), St. Maria im Capitol – Romanic church on a Roman temple site; historical old town with Old Market, city hall with Renaissance arcades, statues of “Tünnes and Scheel” (popular figures symbolising Cologne humour).

Saturday, 02 December: STUTTGART / ESSLINGEN I



Stuttgart: Königstraße, Old Castle with Renaissance arcades, baroque New Castle, Schiller Square with Old Chancellery, **Christmas Market:** splendidly decorated wooden roofs with impressive winter landscapes.
Mercedes-Benz Museum: the museum presents the more than 125 year old history of the automobile.
Esslingen: old imperial city with romantic half-timber houses, historical city hall, St. Paul’s (Germany’s oldest mendicant-order church). **“A historical winter’s tale”** – Mediaeval Market with romantic Christmas market.

Sunday, 03 December: NUREMBERG I

Visit to the finest and most famous German Christmas Market (**“Christkindlesmarkt”**), tour of the city including imperial fortress, Albrecht Dürer House, tomb of St. Sebaldus by Peter Vischer, St. Lorenz with the Angel’s Greeting by Veit Stoß, market square with Frauenkirche church and famous fountain (“Schöner Brunnen”).
Visit to the **Toy Museum** (history of toys from antiquity to the present).

Saturday, 20 January: BAMBERG



Explore Germany’s oldest preserved historical town centre (UNESCO World Heritage): Old City Hall with unique site on a river island, “Little Venice” with original fishermen’s houses; Romanic-Gothic **“Kaiserdom”** (Imperial Cathedral) with the famous **“Bamberg Horseman”** and imperial tomb, Old Palace (Renaissance).

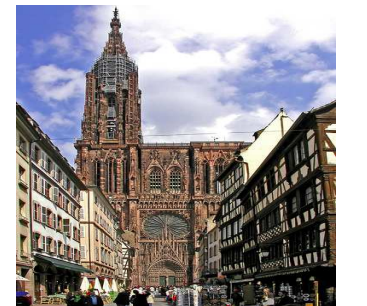
Guided tour of the baroque **New Residence**.

Saturday, 27 January: STRASBOURG

Walk through the Old City (UNESCO World Heritage) including visit to the cathedral (sculptures in the portal of St. Mary and the Pillar of Angels, important glass paintings, famous astronomical clock, etc.); former leather-tanning district **“La Petite France”** with fine half-timber buildings.
Visit to the **Museum of Modern Art**.
“Capital of Europe” Strasbourg with fotostop at the European Parliament.

Monday, 12.02.: CARNIVAL IN DÜSSELDORF

Visit to the Rosenmontag procession in Düsseldorf, one of the highlights of the Rhenish street carnival. This year’s motto **„Jeck erst recht“**.

Thursday, 15 Feb. – Sunday, 18 Feb.: BERLIN



Bus tour of the city including Kurfürstendamm, Brandenburg Gate, “Holocaust-Monument”, Potsdamer Platz, Charlottenburg Castle, Stop at “East-Side Gallery” (Berlin Wall).
Guided walk through the historical city centre: Nikolaiviertel, Rotes Rathaus (Red Town Hall), the Gendarmenmarkt, Berliner Dom, “Museum Island” (UNESCO World Heritage);

Exhibition **„Topographie des Terrors“**;
Visit of **Berlin-Hohenschönhausen Memorial**;
Visit to the **Reichstag building** with its famous new dome, lecture in the **Bundestag** (Federal Diet).
