



FUNDING OF STUDY AND RESEARCH VISITS FOR STUDENTS AND DOCTORAL CANDIDATES OF HEIDELBERG UNIVERSITY AT 4EU+ PARTNER UNIVERSITIES

Heidelberg University is a member of the 4EU+ Alliance, consisting of Charles University in Prague, Heidelberg University, Sorbonne University in Paris, the University of Warsaw, the University of Copenhagen and the University of Milan. 4EU+ aims to create a new quality of cooperation between the six universities in manifold areas. The goal is the creation of a 'European University' with compatible courses of study, flexible study paths for students and manifold mobility options for students and academic staff (www.uni-heidelberg.de/en/4eu-european-university-alliance).

The German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) provides financial support for short-term study visits at a 4EU+ partner in the framework of his supporting programme 'European University Networks'. Eligible to apply are students and doctoral candidates of Heidelberg University.

The following activities can be funded:

- Study visits between 1 to 2 months (Programme A)
- Short-term visits up to 30 days (Programme B)

at 4EU+ partner universities for study and research activities (e.g. participation in regular study programmes or research projects, intensive courses such as block seminars, sommer schools, internships, visits for own research projects, preparartion of final thesis etc.).

- Study/research proposal (1–2 pages)
- Confirmation from partner university/academic tutor (may be submitted later)
- Transcript of records
- If participating in study courses: Proof of language
- School-leaving certificate. Intermediate certificate, Bachelor's/Master's degree (if applicable) in copy

Application documents for group application from academic staff (Programme B)

- 4EU+ application form (groups)
- Description of activity
- Participants list
- Confirmation/invitation letter from partner university

Application deadlines

For mobilities taking place between January and December 2022, applications can be submitted continuously until 30 September 2022.

Applications have to be submitted before the start of the mobility. A backdated funding is not possible.

Please note: Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, all travel subsidies are granted under the reservation that the stays abroad can be realized.
