	The examination will be conducted according to the relevant hygiene protocol; a risk assessment is available.
On-ca	mpus examinations without meeting the distancing requirement:
	The minimum distance of 1.5 m will be met during the whole examination.
	The minimum distance of 1.5 m will not be met because
	□ (1) the room occupation will only be up to 60% of allowed capacity.
	$\square$ (2) the room occupation will be up to 75% of allowed capacity and incidence level 1 to 3 prevails.
	$\square$ (3) the group size will only be up to 35 students (excluding teachers).
	Please note: The precondition for participating in events according to (1), (2) or (3), at which the distancing requirement is not expected to be met, is presenting a current negative test, or evidence of vaccination or recovery (3G). By contrast with the other on-campus events in degree-related operations, there is, by way of exception, no obligation to wear a medical mask or breathing protection in the cases according to (1), (2) or (3). However, in the cases (1) to (3) the implementation of the 3G check mus described and a relevant hygiene protocol must be drawn up pursuant to §6 Coronavirus Ordinance on Degree-Related Operations. The Rectorate will advise the locally competent health authorities of the event.
