



For Heidelberg students and graduates*

In order to promote international exchange, the Baden-Württemberg Foundation is awarding scholarships for stays abroad in the academic year 2022/23 to highly qualified students and graduates. As the Baden-Württemberg Foundation has specified that the exchanges must be on a reciprocal basis, this announcement is primarily intended for participants of exchange programmes (except those under the ERASMUS scheme).

Scholarship amount: 600 € a month for students

800 €a month for PhD students

In justified cases the scholarship may be increased

The scholarship may not be combined with other scholarships intended for the support of a stay abroad (e.g. DAAD). The Baden-Württemberg scholarship counts as income and will lead to a deduction of 300 € a month from the Bafög.

Duration of support: At least three and no more than ten months. Plus, if applicable, one

month for a language course.
