Exchange Programs in Australia

Students at the University of Heidelberg of all study programs (with the exception of medicine) can apply for an exchange at the following five Australian universities:

University of Sydney

One or two exchange places with tuition waiver are available at the University of Sydney, primarily for undergraduate students (with the exception of medicine and law). Founded in 1850, the University of Sydney is Australia's oldest university and offers a high variety of course programs. Macquarie University, Sydney

For graduate students, Macquarie University in Sydney offers the possibility of one or two exchange places with a tuition fee waiver. (Applications are usually only for one semester)

Scholarship: Exemption of tuition fees at the host university; Costs such as *Student*

Service Fee, Recreational Fee and Health insurance are to be paid by

the student.

Requirement: three completed semesters at time of exchange start in Australia

Documents: - in English – to be uploaded online

- Written CV including the study progress (1 page)
- Letter of motivation with study plan for favorite universities in Australia (1-2 pages)
- Two letters of recommendation from university teachers, preferably not directed towards any specific university to be sent to the International Relations Office by the recommender directly (either by mail or email).
- Official transcript / List of study achievements with average grade and confirmation by the faculty
- If applicable, copy of an intermediate examination* (Zwischenprüfung)
 certificate or Bachelor's degree* with an English translation (can be
 created by the applicant themselves)
- TOEFL or IELTS result or registration confirmation
- Copy of secondary school certificate / high school diploma

Application deadline: 21st of June 2022

Only complete applications will be considered; later hand-ins are only accepted after prior consultation with Ms. Doris Treichler.
