WHAT IS THE MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME "TOWARDS A PROFESSORSHIP"?

The management programme "Towards a Professorship" was developed in 2009 within the framework of the Excellence Initiative.

Management programme goals

"Towards a Professorship" prepares you for responsibility in leadership and management at university, supports you in your personal career planning and enables you to develop an interdisciplinary network.

Target group

Eligible are postdocs (at least two years after earning their doctorate), habilitation candidates, junior research group leaders, as well as junior professors with and without tenure track from all faculties and institutes at Heidelberg University.



Procedure and scope

The management programme "Towards a Professorship" is divided into three seminar modules lasting 2 to 3 days each. These take place partly in Heidelberg and partly in an external conference centre. In addition, individual coaching and peer coaching are available as supplementary options.
