



## HOW DO I FIND ACCOMMODATION IN HEIDELBERG?

### INFORMATION FOR GRADUATES OF GERMAN SCHOOLS ABROAD

---

Are you considering to study at Heidelberg University or have you even already been accepted to the university? In the latter case, Congratulations! An exciting stage of your life is about to begin in one of Germany's most beautiful cities. Unfortunately, as is the case in many other student towns in Germany, the situation on Heidelberg's housing market is very tense which makes it even more problematic to find accommodation while still abroad. Therefore, one of the first things which you should look after is your search for a flat, a room in a shared flat or in one of the university's dormitories.

The Accommodation Service of the International Relations Office will gladly assist you in finding proper accommodation. We can provide you with information about the application procedures for the different dormitories as well as support you in your search on the private housing market. On the following pages we have compiled for you a list of different contact points for the search of accommodation, as well as a list of church and private dormitories. On request we can also provide you with a current list of room and flat offers.

#### PLEASE NOTE:

Do not transfer any money before you have seen the accommodation or been in contact with the landlord. Be careful with landlords who apparently live abroad and ask you to transfer money for example via Western Union or MoneyGram. It is always best to visit accommodation and meet the landlord in person. In case of serious doubt, it is better to refrain from the offer.

Before moving into an apartment you set up a written rental lease with your future landlord. The lease should include the following information: basic monthly rental charge not including monthly additional costs such as hot water (Kaltmiete), monthly additional costs (Nebenkosten), starting date and duration of the rental period or term of notice for open ended contracts (usually 3 months).

### **A FINAL TIP:**

In terms of area, Heidelberg is a relatively small town, yet it has a lot of inhabitants. The very few rooms which are located within the direct vicinity of the university campuses (Altstadt and Neuenheim) are usually more expensive than those in other areas of the town, or outside it. Other areas of the town, as well as surrounding neighbourhoods such as Dossenheim, Leimen, Eppelheim or Neckargemünd, are very well connected to the city centre by public transport links. You could also consider finding accommodation in Mannheim. Rent levels in Mannheim are considerably lower than those in Heidelberg and the city is only 15 minutes away by train (S-Bahn).
