Access to Electron Microscopy Core Facility (EMCF)

The EMCF is a DFG-registered service facility (RI_00565), which provides technical and scientific support for transmission and scanning electron microscopy to all members of the University of Heidelberg and associated research institutions. If our time permits, we also offer our services to customers outside the University of Heidelberg. Priority will however be given to members of Heidelberg University. External users from academic institutions will be charged our regular fee, for external users from commercial organizations the fee must be negotiated before the start of the project.

Starting a project

To start a project at EMCF you should first send a short description of your EM question to emcf@uni-heidelberg.de. Thereafter we will set up a meeting with EMCF staff to review the feasibility of the project and to discuss how to proceed. Before the onset of a project the contact and billing information sheet must be filled in and the fee agreement signed.

Charging

At EMCF we offer two different charging systems:

- 1. a flat fee system in which the use of all equipment except the F20 tecnai microscope is included. Use of the F20 microscope comes with an additional hourly fee.
- 2. An hourly fee for all equipment for short term users.

Booking

Booking can be done through our booking system. Access to the booking system will be given after appropriate training. Booking hours for all equipment are Monday to Friday at 8.00 to 17.00. Work in the lab at different hours is only permitted when more than one person is present in the lab.

Publication guidelines: Any publication where the microscopes or support from EMCF members was used must include an acknowledgment sentence like: "We are thankful for the support from the electron microscopy core facility (EMCF) at Heidelberg university."

If EMCF staff is actively involved in research projects more than introducing equipment and consultation, then the EMCF member should be regarded as a co-author in the publication.
