OLYMPIA MORATA-PROGRAM

PROGRAM FOR THE PROMOTION OF FEMALE* POSTDOCTORAL RESEARCHERS

The aim of the Olympia Morata-Program is to support above-average female (*i.e. FLINTA*) postdoctoral researchers with an outstanding qualification project in the R2 Phase (the doctorate should have been completed no longer than 3-4 years ago).

The program consists of five pillars:

1) Funds for a part-time position (pay grade 13/TV-L); it is assumed that the institutes at which the applicants work will also provide part-time positions (EG 13/TV-L) or corresponding personnel funds; **2)** Coaching, consultations and career development consultations; **3)** Networking(events); **4)** Continuing education and courses; **5)** Eligibility to apply to the Fund^{Family}.

The funding application must include the following documents:

1. Letter of application with information on the academic career and professional goals
2. Certified copy of the doctoral degree
3. Binding commitment by the faculty/institute that a position (EG 13/TV-L, 50%) or corresponding personnel resources with infrastructure will be made available
4. Exposé of the qualification project
5. Two letters of recommendation, about the applicants development potential in the subject and on the qualification project, at least one of which must be an external expert opinion
6. Questionnaire (application form will be sent after consultation with UNIFY)

The **selection** of candidates is based on an evaluation of the applications received by a selection committee.
