



Science and Research Day 2011 “Life Sciences” 29 June 2011, Neue Universität Heidelberg

On 29 June 2011, the third Science and Research Day of the Baden-Wuerttemberg Stiftung takes place at the New University of Heidelberg.

We invite scientists from all over Southern Germany, as well as representatives of politics and companies. Some 1,000 participants are expected to attend the event. Crucial for us is to offer the opportunity to get in contact, to exchange information, and to further a network amongst representatives of science and business.

Our keynote speakers in the morning are Prof. Paul Kirchhof, Director of the Institute for Fiscal and Tax Law, University of Heidelberg and Former Justice of the Federal Constitutional Court of Germany; Prof. Flossie Wong-Staal, Chief Scientific Officer, iTherX Pharmaceuticals Inc. and Professor of Biology/Medicine, University of San Diego; Prof. Randy W. Schekman, 2002 Albert Lasker Award for Basic Medical Research, Howard Hughes Investigator and Professor of Cell and Developmental Biology, UC Berkeley; and Prof. Erwin Neher, 1991 Nobel Prize for Physiology or Medicine, Scientific Member and Director of the Max Planck Institute for Biophysical Chemistry, Goettingen.

In the afternoon, we present concurrent workshops on adult human stem cells, trends and highlights in biomedical sciences, and proteomics that deal for instance with adult epidermal stem cells, chemical proteomics in drug discovery, and biomarkerprofiling in major human diseases.

Moreover, a poster exhibition will present about 100 projects that deal with current questions in life sciences funded by the Baden-Wuerttemberg Stiftung.
