

CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION AND PARTICIPATION FOR ALL MEMBERS AND VISITORS OF HEIDELBERG UNIVERSITY

BASED ON THE CORONA ORDINANCE OF THE STATE OF BADEN-WÜRTTEMBERG IN CONNECTION WITH THE CORONA ORDINANCE ON DEGREE-RELATED OPERATIONS AND THE ARTS IN THEIR LATEST VERSIONS

Data collection

Pursuant to § 14 cl. 1 no. 1, § 10 par. 1 and § 6 Corona Ordinance of the State of Baden-Württemberg, as appropriate in connection with § 4 par. 1 Corona Ordinance on Degree-related Operations and the Arts the following details must be obtained from participants of every single event, users of university facilities with degree-related operations, visitors to advisory and administrative services such as student secretariats:

first and last name, address, date and time of attendance and telephone number.

The university is further obligated to exclude persons who refuse to provide this information from using the facility or taking part in the class/event.

The data privacy statement is made available whenever information is collected and can be viewed on the university's data protection website.

Prohibition of admission and participation

According to § 7 of the Corona Ordinance of the State of Baden-Württemberg, entering the university and attending classes or events is prohibited

- 1. if you are or were in contact with a person who is infected with coronavirus and if the last contact occurred less than 14 days ago, or
- 2. if you are displaying typical symptoms of a coronavirus infection, i.e. a high temperature, dry coughing, disorders of your sense of taste or smell, or
- 3. if you do not respect your obligation to wear a mask protecting your mouth and nose in corridors and areas of circulation (from 30 September).

In entering the university and taking part in classes or events, you declare that the aforementioned grounds for exclusion Nos. 1 and 2 do not apply to you.

If you believe that the prohibition of admission and participation is unreasonable in your particular case, please contact the head of the facility or the person responsible for the class or event.
