## COURSE SELECTION

Both at the undergraduate level and the graduate level, one full module consists of either one lecture and one seminar in the same field of study (e.g. International Relations) or two seminars in the same field of study. Please get in contact with your Home University for their criteria in which and how many courses/ modules you should complete during your stay.

## ECTS-SYSTEM

For graded certifications the following ECTS-points are given by the Institute for Political Science:

Undergraduate Level (BA)	Credits
<b>Compulsory modules</b>	
Attended lecture only with the requirement of attendance	2 ECTS-points
Attended lecture plus exam/term paper	4 ECTS-points
Seminar Course presentation	2 ECTS-points
Seminar exam	4 ECTS-points
<b>Elective modules</b>	
Seminar Course presentation	2 ECTS-points
Term paper	6 ECTS-points

Graduate Level (MA)	Credits
Single course of elective module with longer term paper and presentation	8 ECTS-points
Single course of elective module with short essay and presentation	4 ECTS-points
Course of comprehensive skill module (presentation)	2 ECTS-points

Normally, there will not be given any ECTS-points for lectures or seminar without an examination, through either a written or oral exam / presentation or a term paper. There are some exceptions, where credits are given for regular attendance.

**You must register online (via HeiCO) not only for the courses but also for every examination.** Presentations must be registered around the beginning of November (for the winter semester) resp. the beginning of May (for the summer semester), and term papers and essays by February resp. July the latest. Please be aware that these dates can change. For written examinations, the last chance to sign in/out is one week before the exam.

If you would like to choose courses from other faculties, please be sure to inform on registration, ECTS-points, deadlines etc. on your own via the course catalogue or the lecturers. If you should still have questions, please contact us by the e-mail address listed above.

**Checking out your grades before receiving the transcript:**

Courses, which are attended at our department, will be recorded online. You can check on your enrolment for courses, your registrations for examinations and your credits and grades obtained online as soon as they are registered. To do so, please access our online system HeiCO.

**What you need to do to receive a Transcript of Records:**

To receive a ToR you will need to send a filled in "List of Courses" to the Erasmus Assistants via E-mail.

In addition to the List of Courses, we require proof for all courses listed on the form.

<b>Courses taken at the IPW</b>	You <u>do not need to</u> send proof for these courses, as we will receive this information from the examinations office
<b>Courses <u>not</u> taken at the IPW</b>	<p>These Courses <u>will need to</u> be certified by a written document, called "Schein".</p> <p>Each department or faculty has blank forms of written certificates, which can be received from their secretary's office, online on their webpage or directly from the lecturer.</p> <p>The grades and ECTS you received need to be listed on these Scheine.</p>

Please make sure, to send the filled in List of Courses **together in one E-Mail** with all supporting certificates to [erasmus@ipw.uni-heidelberg.de](mailto:erasmus@ipw.uni-heidelberg.de) at the end of your stay. Please hesitate from sending multiple E-Mails with single documents.

**A transcript will only be issued if you have sent in all mentioned documents.**
