



HOW DO I FIND ACCOMMODATION IN HEIDELBERG?

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Accommodation Service of the International Relations Office is the first point of contact for the search regarding accommodation in Heidelberg for all foreign (short term-) students, PhD students and scholars.

We provide information about the housing conditions in Heidelberg and support you in finding accommodation on the private housing market. Additionally to the student halls of the Studierendenwerk, there are a range of private dorms that you can apply for.

Please note: All of the following accommodation do not belong to the Heidelberg University and are not related to it. We do not give a warranty or guarantee for the quality of the listed accommodation and we cannot guarantee placement. We aim for completeness of the information.

PLEASE NOTE:

Do not transfer any money before you have seen the accommodation or been in contact with the landlord. Be careful with landlords who apparently live abroad and ask you to transfer money for example via Western Union or MoneyGram. It is always best to visit accommodation and meet the landlord in person. In case of serious doubt, it is better to refrain from the offer.

Before moving into an apartment you set up a written rental lease with your future landlord. The lease should include the following information: basic monthly rental charge not including monthly additional costs such as hot water (Kaltmiete), monthly additional costs (Nebenkosten), starting date and duration of the rental period or term of notice for open ended contracts (usually 3 months).

Applications which are submitted later have less chance of being successful (Tip: if you have not yet been admitted to your selected degree programme, you can still apply for a room in a hall of residence - simply attach a copy of your application for study at the University to the application for accommodation).

A final tip:

In terms of area, Heidelberg is a relatively small town, yet it has a lot of inhabitants. The very few rooms which are located within the direct vicinity of the university campuses (Altstadt and Neuenheim) are usually more expensive than those in other areas of the town, or outside it. Other areas of the town, as well as surrounding neighbourhoods such as Dossenheim, Leimen, Eppelheim or Neckargemünd, are very well connected to the city centre by public transport links. You could also consider finding accommodation in Mannheim. Rent levels in Mannheim are considerably lower than those in Heidelberg and the city is only 15 minutes away by train (S-Bahn).
