Islam is the youngest among the three main monotheistic religions. As such, it was actually born into a conflicting situation. During the long process of its formation, young Islam integrated many Jewish and Christian conceptions and institutions. Later on, while turning into a victorious worldwide civilization, Islam could affect and mold many aspects of the Jewish (and Christian) cultures. The proposed course will focus on the continuous winding dialogue between Islam and Judaism in the Middle-Ages. Participants are expected to read and discuss scholarly works and summarize one of them for the other members of the group.
