## Funding of Core Facilities by HMLS

Dear Scientists,

Cutting-edge **core technology platforms** on the basis of existing infrastructure can realize synergies and thus not only contribute to the aims of the comprehensive university, but also become cost-effective. To provide an incentive for core facilities and scientists offering technical services to the community, HMLS provides additional support for core infrastructure development.

Applications for partial funding matched with additional funding sources are highly appreciated. Funding may be used for technical equipment, consumables or (part time) personnel.

Proposals may be submitted by members of the Molecular Life Sciences institutions (Faculties of Biosciences Heidelberg, and Faculties of Medicine Heidelberg and Mannheim, DKFZ, EMBL, MPI-mF).

For successful proposals, it is mandatory to provide a detailed implementation plan for the envisaged technology, including a valid quotation as well as a long-term perspective for successful operation, and an accessible website. Also, the add on value of the specific measure for the entire HMLS research community has to be documented. Proposals also have to consider the sustainability aspect, i.e. how will the new technology platform or the new instrument or service operates after the funding. Funding for room, construction, and maintenance costs is not offered by HMLS and has to be provided by applicant(s).



All submitted proposals will be reviewed and ranked by the HMLS Research Council. Deadline for submission (one single pdf) is **May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019**. **Procurements have to be completed (purchased, fully spent and booked) before October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2019**.
