

Dear visitors, colleagues and students,

with this leaflet, Heidelberg University and Heidelberg University Hospital want to help you find your way around on the campus Im Neuenheimer Feld and make sure that you reach your destination safely.

This overview shows you the services and measures designed to increase safety on the campus. Please do not hesitate to avail yourself of these services, which are free of charge. You may, for instance, use the security escort service if you do not want to walk alone in the dark from your place of work to your car or to the bus stop. We have also listed non-university services, some of them with costs, such as the women's night taxi. The German and English versions of this leaflet are also available online on the website of Heidelberg University.

Even the best safety measures are ineffective if we do not pay attention and look out for ourselves and for others. This means walking together after an event or on the way home from work and watching out for each other. It also means not abandoning others if they are threatened.

If you have problems, suggestions or criticism regarding our safety measures, please contact the university or the university hospital. Your input helps us to better adjust these measures to your needs. Be safe!

Security escort service of Universität Heidelberg

After nightfall, female students and staff members on the Campus Im Neuenheimer Feld (INF) may request to be escorted to their place of work, their car, the bus or tram stop or their dormitory by a member of the security service. This free escort service is also available to female students who arrive in the evening from downtown by bus or train and want to be escorted safely to their dormitory.

Security escort service of Heidelberg University Hospital

Staff members and visitors of Heidelberg University Hospital may request to be escorted to the parking lot, their place of work, a bus or tram stop or their dormitory all night by a member of the security service. Security guards may be contacted around the clock, either directly at the reception or the Direction and Information Centre 1 (LIZ), or by telephone. Phone 06221/56-39978

The night operations manager may be contacted by telephone between 7 pm and 7 am. Phone 06221/56-39971

Women's night taxi

With the Women's Night Taxi, women from the age of 14 whose primary residence is in Heidelberg can travel by taxi at reduced fares within the Heidelberg city limits. The taxis can be called by telephone or hailed on the street. Tickets for the night taxi must be bought in advance (Frauen-Nachttaxischein). Up to four women can ride together with one ticket. Not all taxis accept the tickets, so you will have to check with the driver before your ride.

- Tickets are available in the Local Administration Offices (Bürgeramt)

Bus lines 31 and 32

After nightfall, passengers on the bus lines 31 and 32 can leave the bus in between the regular bus stops in the Neuenheimer Feld district in order to avoid long walks in the dark. Simply tell the driver beforehand where you would like the bus to stop. www.rnv-online.de

Self-defence

Self-defence classes with various focus areas are offered by a number of organisations: students can participate in a self-defence class based on JuJutsu that is held all through the lecture period at the Institute of Sports and Sports Sciences within the framework of the university sports programme. The Student Services Organisation (Studierendenwerk) also offers self-assertion courses for female students several times throughout the semester.

PRECAUTIONS

- Use lighted walkways
- Park in women's parking spaces
- Call the security escort service
- Do not leave the walkways and avoid circuitous routes
- Whistles frequently scare attackers away and will alarm the security guards
